BE LEGAL! Help Brazil grow

• fruits, vegetables

- milk, cheese, butter, yogurt, dulce de leche
- honey, wax, propolis
- pets
- fresh or industrialized meats, (ham, canned products, fish)
- insects, mollusks, bacteria and fungi
- pet food, eggs, semen, embryos, pesticides and veterinary products (serum, vaccines, medications, among others)
- seedlings, seeds, fresh vegetables, wood and soil
- food served on board



Before traveling

- Obtain the authorization from the Animal and Plant Inspection
- Consult the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate about the requirements for the imports of animals, plants and other products

When coming to Brazil

Inform on the "Accompanied Baggage
Declaration" (ABD) what you are bringing
If necessary, obtain the Official Sanitary
Certificate from the country of origin
