See the list of animal and plant products which may not enter into Brazil without previous authorization and/or sanitary certification:

ATTENTION

- fruits, vegetables
- milk, cheese, butter, yogurt, dulce de leche
- honey, wax, propolis
- pets
- fresh or industrialized meats, (ham, canned products, fish)
- insects, mollusks, bacteria and fungi
- pet food, eggs, semen, embryos, pesticides and veterinary products (serum, vaccines, medications, among others)
- seedlings, seeds, fresh vegetables, wood and soil
- food served on board

Help Brazil grow



Before traveling

- Obtain the authorization from the Animal and Plant Inspection
- Consult the Brazilian Embassy or Consulate about the requirements for the imports of animals, plants and other products

When coming to Brazil

- Inform on the “Accompanied Baggage Declaration” (ABD) what you are bringing
- If necessary, obtain the Official Sanitary Certificate from the country of origin
