

Notice for Public Call 2022-2023

of the Program of Support for the Translation and Publication  
of Brazilian Authors Abroad

Art. 1 Fundação Biblioteca Nacional will offer financial support:

- I. To foreign publishers that wish to translate, publish and distribute abroad works by Brazilian authors previously published in Brazil;
- II. Exceptionally, to Brazilian publishers that, with justified reasons, wish to translate into another language previously published works in Portuguese on the Independence of Brazil, for international distribution in the context of the celebrations of the bicentenary of the political emancipation of the country.

Art. 2 This Announcement is in compliance with the Regulations of the Program of Support for the Translation and Publication of Brazilian Authors Abroad, of July 1st, 2021, available at <https://www.bn.gov.br/edital/2022/regulamento-programa-traducao-fbn-regulation-fbns>.

Art. 3 For the purposes of this Announcement, the funds provided for 2022 will be initially allocated, in the amount of R\$ 68,000.00 (sixty eight thousand reais), from Action 20ZF - Promotion and Fostering of Brazilian Culture, of the *Lei Orçamentária Anual* [Annual Budget Law]. The granting of financial support is subject to the availability of budget.

Sole paragraph. The financial resources granted to Brazilian publishers are intended solely to defray the costs related to the translation of the proposed work in the foreign language, and the publisher is responsible for all expenses related to the publication and distribution of the book.

Art. 4 Applications must be made exclusively through the e-mail [translation@bn.gov.br](mailto:translation@bn.gov.br).

Art. 5 This Announcement is valid for 24 months, as of the date of the opening Ordinance. During this period, registrations will observe the following schedule:

- I. Application: until May 15<sup>th</sup> or October 15<sup>th</sup>.
- II. Qualification: until May 31<sup>st</sup> or October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- III. Selection: until June 30<sup>th</sup> or November 30<sup>th</sup>.
