EXPORTAÇÃO DE PRODUTOS ORGÂNICOS BRASILEIROS PARA O CANADÁ

Pesquisa elaborada pelo Setor de Promoção Comercial (SECOM) do Consulado Geral do Brasil em Vancouver



1. INTRODUÇÃO

Com a regulamentação da legislação nacional sobre orgânicos de 2011, a oferta de produtos orgânicos no mercado brasileiro tem crescido fortemente. Em outubro de 2016, o Ministério da Agricultura divulgou que a agricultura orgânica movimentou cerca de R\$ 2 bilhões e a expectativa é que, em 2016, esse número alcance R\$ 2,5 bilhões.¹ A produção de orgânicos está distribuída por todas as regiões do país, e quase ¼ dos municípios brasileiros registram esse tipo de produção.²

Em paralelo ao crescimento nacional, o governo federal vem fomentando o aumento da exportação de produtos orgânicos brasileiros. Atualmente, o Brasil exporta produtos orgânicos para quase 80 países, e os dez destinos com maior volume de produtos em 2015 foram, por ordem: EUA, Alemanha, Holanda, Canadá, França, Reino Unido, Argentina, Austrália, Suécia e Bélgica. Os principais produtos exportados foram matérias primas semi-processadas, como: açúcar, óleo de dendê e outros óleos vegetais, castanha de caju, sucos de frutas (açai), mel, erva-mate, frutas tropicais congeladas, café, preparações capilares, própolis e cachaça.³

Várias iniciativas vêm sendo desenvolvidas para ampliar o número de países-destino dos orgânicos brasileiros, bem como o volume, diversificar os produtos exportados, e facilitar a entrada em mercados. A Apex é uma das entidades do governo federal mais engajadas nessa meta de internacionalização de empresas brasileiras que produzem orgânicos, com destaque para o programa “Organics Brasil”.

É nesse contexto de expansão e de busca de novas oportunidades que se situa o presente estudo de mercado. O objetivo geral é fornecer panorama geral do potencial para a venda de produtos orgânicos brasileiros no mercado canadense, com especial atenção para a província da Colúmbia Britânica.

2. O MERCADO DE PRODUTOS ORGÂNICOS NO CANADÁ

O Canadá possui um dos mais fortes mercados de orgânicos no mundo. O valor do mercado canadense de orgânicos está estimado em CAD\$ 4 bilhões/ano (FiBL & IFOAM, 2016). O país é o 5º maior mercado consumidor de alimentos orgânicos, e está entre os dez maiores consumidores per capita de produtos orgânicos (Figura 1). Excluindo-se o mercado europeu, o Canadá é o 2º maior do mundo no ranking de consumo de orgânicos per capita (Figura 2).

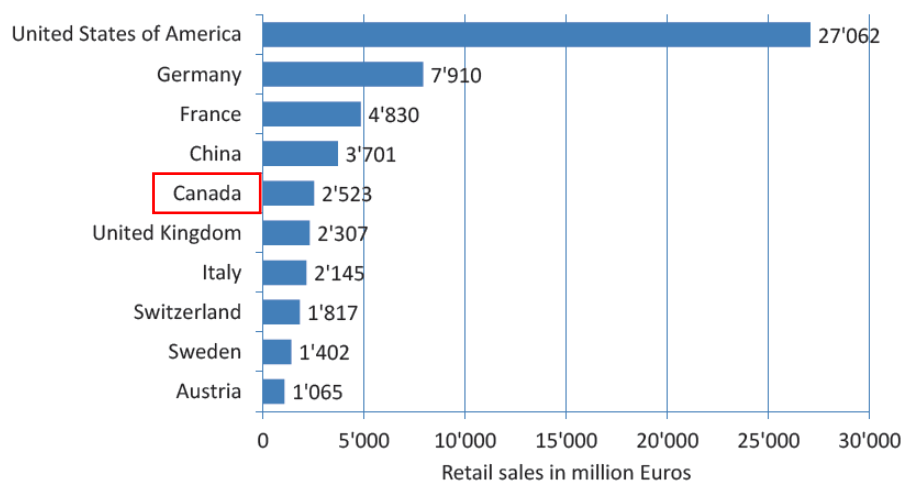


Figura 1: Países com maiores mercados para alimentos orgânicos, 2014

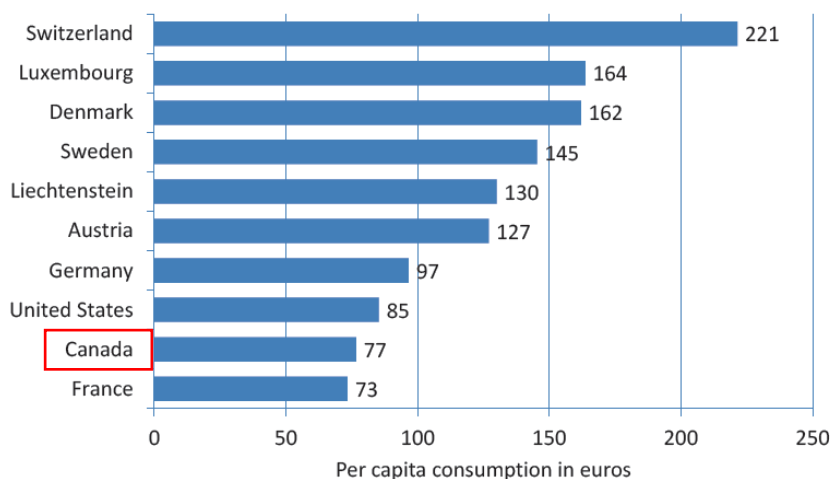


Figura 2: Países com maior consumo per capita de alimentos orgânicos, 2014

A demanda por produtos orgânicos vem se expandindo continuamente desde a segunda metade dos anos 2000. De acordo com um estudo detalhado, publicado pela *Canada Organic Trade Association* (COTA), em 2013, 98% dos canadenses declararam que sua expectativa era de manter o nível ou consumir mais produtos orgânicos nos próximos anos. Juntamente com a crescente demanda doméstica, acordos comerciais têm facilitado a venda de produtos orgânicos canadenses para os

Estados Unidos, Japão e Europa, fomentando o interesse na produção desses produtos (COTA, 2013a). O mercado canadense de orgânicos cresceu 20% entre 2013 e 2014, e a expectativa é de continuação no crescimento anual do setor em dois dígitos (FiBL & IFOAM, 2016).

Estima-se que 58% dos canadenses comprem produtos orgânicos semanalmente; essa frequência sobe para 61% entre aqueles com nível superior, e 63% entre os habitantes de grandes centros urbanos (COTA, 2013a). A escolha por produtos orgânicos está alinhada com valores sociais e ligadas a considerações de saúde e meio ambiente. A busca dos consumidores por transparência é uma outra tendência que reforça o interesse por orgânicos e a atenção para certificação e garantia de qualidade dos produtos. A expectativa de consumo de produtos orgânicos é bastante alta entre os jovens consumidores entre 18 e 34 anos. O consumo de produtos orgânicos por essa fatia do mercado já é elevado, e espera-se que cresça à medida que eles tenham filhos.

1.1. PROVÍNCIAS

No mercado canadense de produtos orgânicos, a província de Ontário possui o maior volume de compras: 30% do consumo nacional. No entanto, o destaque nacional é para a província da Colúmbia Britânica, onde os produtos orgânicos possuem maior preferência de consumo. Enquanto apenas 13% da população canadense vive na província, em 2013 seus habitantes foram responsáveis por 26% das compras de alimentos orgânicos do país e 22% da compra de alimentos e bebidas orgânicos no Canadá.

Dois-terços da população da Colúmbia Britânica consome produtos orgânicos semanalmente – trata-se da província com o número mais alto de consumo semanal per capita (Figura 4). Entre outros motivos, deve-se às atitudes e percepções da população dessa província em relação a produtos orgânicos (COTA, 2013b):

- Mais da metade dos habitantes da Colúmbia Britânica acreditam que a agricultura orgânica é melhor para um meio ambiente saudável e que produtos orgânicos são mais nutritivos;
- Mais da metade dos habitantes da Colúmbia Britânica procuram evitar Organismos Geneticamente Modificados (OGM) em sua alimentação;
- Dois-terços dos habitantes da Colúmbia Britânica estão dispostos a pagar mais por alimentos que eles acreditam ser mais saudáveis para eles e suas famílias, e
- Os habitantes dessa província são mais atentos à leitura de rótulos em produtos do que os de outras províncias canadenses.

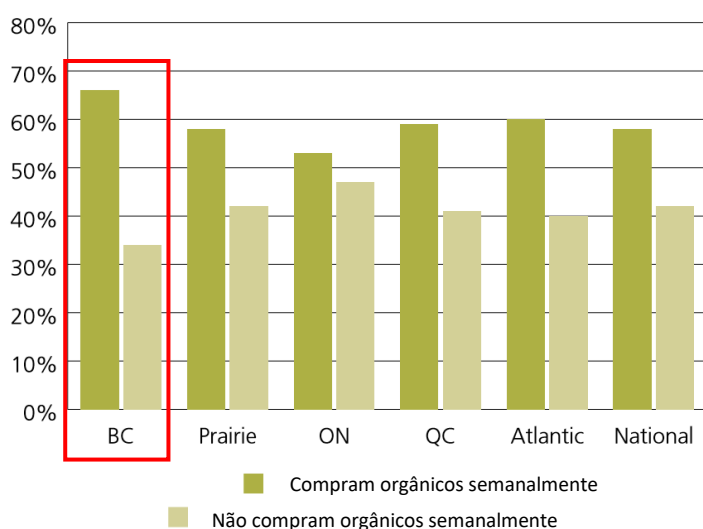


Figura 4. Percentual da população que compra produtos orgânicos semanalmente

Avalia-se que esse comportamento seja fruto de um pioneirismo histórico da província com movimentos a favor da natureza e percepção de saúde de um ponto de vista holístico. Cabe ressaltar que a ONG Greenpeace nasceu em Vancouver no início dos anos 1970, e que a província da Colúmbia Britânica é aquela com o maior número de lojas de produtos naturais per capita do país (COTA, 2013^a, 2013b). A conjunção desses fatores, apoiada pela renda per capita elevada, facilitou o surgimento e a consolidação de uma comunidade de consumidores “ecologicamente conscientes” e dispostos a pagarem mais por produtos orgânicos.

Na província da Colúmbia Britânica, o consumo semanal de produtos orgânicos é bastante elevado em vários grupos sociais (COTA, 2013b):

- 78% daqueles na faixa etária de 55-64 anos;
- 79% das famílias com rendimento anual superior a CAD\$ 100.000;
- 75% das famílias com pelo menos uma criança com menos de 2 anos, e 70% entre as famílias com pelo menos uma criança entre 2-17 anos;
- 73% daqueles com nível superior.

A cidade de Vancouver – a maior na província da Colúmbia Britânica, e centro da terceira maior região metropolitana do país – é a mais forte do Canadá para o mercado de alimentos orgânicos: 78% de seus habitantes compram esses produtos semanalmente (COTA, 2013b).

1.2. PRODUTOS

No Canadá, não restam dúvidas de que o segmento dominante na venda de orgânicos é o de alimentos. De acordo com dados de 2012, o mercado total para produtos orgânicos foi de CAD\$ 3,5 bilhões; desse total, 80% – CAD\$ 2,8 bilhões – foram gastos no setor de comidas e bebidas orgânicas (excluindo bebidas alcoólicas), como detalhado na Figura 5.

Nacionalmente, a maior parte do consumo de alimentos orgânicos ocorre no setor de frutas e verduras, responsável por 40% das vendas. Em seguida, bebidas (16%), laticínios e ovos (15%), pães e grãos (12%), e alimentos preparados/industrializados (8%); finalmente, condimentos e lanches (“snacks”), cada um com 4% do mercado, e 1% de carnes.

No critério bebidas, o café orgânico é o produto mais consumido. O mercado canadense de café – orgânico ou não – é considerável. A bebida é nada menos do que a mais popular entre adultos (>16 anos) canadenses: estima-se que dois-terços dos adultos do país consomem pelo menos uma xícara de café por dia, com uma média de 3,2 xícaras/dia; em 2015, a indústria do café no Canadá movimentou CAD\$ 6,2 bilhões. Ou seja, existe clara oportunidade para vendas de café orgânico brasileiro no mercado canadense, tanto café verde quanto torrado. A tendência atual é de valorização do café de origem única (ao invés de *blends*), por produtos com certificações orgânica e ética (“fair trade”), e com indicação de como o café foi cultivado, processado e torrado. Nas palavras de um porta-voz da Associação Canadense de Café, “os consumidores valorizam transparência”.⁴

Ainda em relação ao consumo de café orgânico, novamente a província que mais se destaca é a Colúmbia Britânica. Apesar de contar com somente 13% da população nacional, 35% de todo consumo de café (verde) orgânico do país ocorre nessa província. Como detalhado na Figura 6, à exceção de frutas e verduras, esse foi o produto orgânico mais consumido na província em 2012. Segundo o diretor da Associação Canadense de Café, em 2012 a familiaridade [*awareness*], no nível nacional, com as designações “café fair trade” e “café orgânico” era de 51% e 58%, respectivamente; em comparação, o grau de familiaridade com essas mesmas categorias entre o público da Colúmbia Britânica era de 65% e 87%. Enquanto 28% dos entrevistados de uma pesquisa feita pela Associação diziam comprar café orgânico, esse número na Columbia Britânica era de 42%.⁵

Além do café orgânico, existe uma percepção de que a falta de tempo disponível no dia-a-dia reforça o interesse em produtos alimentícios convenientes, tais como frutas e verduras orgânicos congelados. Segundo o relatório do COTA (2013), a oferta desses produtos nesse formato ainda é limitada. Acreditamos que esse seja outro setor com grandes possibilidades para produtos brasileiros, já que o congelamento é uma forma de minimizar o impacto da distância na venda de frutas frescas e facilmente perecíveis e ainda contribui para a agregação de valor ao produto.

3. REGULAMENTAÇÃO DE PRODUTOS ORGÂNICOS

Desde 2009, os produtos orgânicos comercializados no Canadá estão sujeitos à certificação federal obrigatória. A única exceção é feita a produtos produzidos e comercializados dentro da mesma província, que ficam isentos da obrigatoriedade. A *Canadian Food Inspection Agency* (CFIA) é a agência do governo federal canadense encarregada de regulamentar os produtos que se apresentam como orgânicos comercializados 1) entre províncias, e/ou 2) importados de outros países ou exportados a partir do Canadá.

Além da certificação nacional, algumas províncias possuem suas próprias certificações provinciais, caso da Colúmbia Britânica, Manitoba, Quebec, e Nova Brunswick. Essas certificações subnacionais são voluntárias; no entanto, em 2018, haverá na Colúmbia Britânica a obrigatoriedade de certificação orgânica provincial para a venda de todos os produtos alimentícios ditos orgânicos.

A legislação federal – aplicável a todos os produtos importados para o país – define quais os produtos são de fato orgânicos, de modo que os consumidores não estejam sendo vítimas de propaganda enganosa. O documento detalhando todas as especificações e requerimentos referentes ao uso apropriado do termo “orgânico” chama-se *Organic Products Regulations*.

Um produto é considerado certificado como orgânico se ele tiver sido certificado por uma organização acreditada que esteja de acordo com o *Canadian Organic Standards*. Qualquer rótulo que apresente o logotipo de certificação orgânica canadense ou diga conter mais de 70% de ingredientes orgânicos é obrigado a incluir o nome da organização certificadora. O uso do logotipo “*Canada Organic*” é voluntário, mas só é permitido para produtos com mais de 95% de conteúdo orgânico, devidamente comprovado de acordo com os requerimentos das regras federais.



Pela regulamentação federal, algumas declarações são proibidas por lei. Por exemplo, nenhum produto pode declarar-se “100% orgânico”: todo produto com conteúdo orgânico >95% é considerado “orgânico”. A frase “*certified organic*” (“certificado como orgânico”) a princípio também não é permitida, por implicar que nem todos os produtos orgânicos vendidos no país são certificados, quando de fato *todos* os produtos orgânicos passam por certificação federal. Permite-se o uso da frase somente se vier acompanhada pela entidade responsável pela certificação (“*certified organic by...*”). A legislação federal também não permite a expressão “produzido(a) com ingredientes orgânicos”.

Produtos com 70% a 95% de conteúdo orgânico devem declarar o percentual de orgânicos na embalagem, e produtos com menos de 70% de conteúdo orgânico podem indicar somente quais ingredientes são orgânicos no rótulo de ingredientes.

No caso de produtos importados, existem dois caminhos para que esses possam se apresentar no mercado canadense como orgânicos. O primeiro é a certificação pela CFIA com base no *Canadian Organic Standards*. A outra forma decorre da existência de um acordo de equivalência para produtos orgânicos entre um país e o Canadá. Nesse caso, os produtos podem ser certificados por uma entidade que seja acreditada no país estrangeiro e reconhecida pelo governo canadense. Atualmente, o Canadá possui acordos de equivalência em certificação de orgânicos com os Estados Unidos, Suíça, União Europeia, Japão e Costa Rica. Produtos orgânicos oriundos desses países não precisam passar por certificação canadense para a venda no mercado local com tal diferenciação, pois a certificação originária é considerada automaticamente válida no mercado canadense. Desse modo, produtos brasileiros, mesmo que reconhecidos como orgânicos pela lei brasileira, não são automaticamente reconhecidos como orgânicos no mercado canadense.

Recomenda-se que empresas brasileiras produtoras de orgânicos entrem em contato direto com o escritório federal responsável pela certificação orgânica no Canadá – *Canada Organics Office* – a respeito de dúvidas e procedimentos específicos.

4. DISTRIBUIÇÃO E VENDA

De modo a facilitar os contatos entre empresas brasileiras interessadas em exportar produtos orgânicos para o Oeste do Canadá, encontra-se anexo documento, intitulado “*Western Canada Organic Business Directory*”, ou “Diretório de Negócios Orgânicos no Oeste Canadense”.

Publicado em 2014, o material fornece informações detalhadas de empresas e organizações relevantes para aqueles que desejam entrar no mercado local. Encorajamos fortemente leitura atenta do material para identificação de potenciais compradores, distribuidores e importadores. O contato das empresas brasileiras com esses possíveis parceiros pode ser feito diretamente ou por intermédio do SECOM Vancouver.

O diretório começa com a listagem das principais associações privadas nacionais e provinciais ligadas a produtos orgânicos: *Canadian Organic Trade Association* (COTA), *Canadian Organic Growers* (COG) e *Organic Federation of Canada* (OFC); *Alberta Organic Producers Association* (AOPA) e *Organic Alberta*, *Certified Organic Association of British Columbia* (COABC), *Saskatchewan Organic Directorate* (SOD), e *Manitoba Organic Alliance* (MOA) – observando-se que essa última província está sob a jurisdição do SECOM Toronto.

Em seguida, encontram-se listadas as entidades certificadoras acreditadas pelo governo federal canadense, seguidas daquelas acreditadas para certificação apenas na província da Colúmbia Britânica. Depois, o contato para programas de consultoria, educação e extensão relacionados ao cultivo e venda de orgânicos.

O diretório disponibiliza a seguir contatos diretos para compradores e vendedores de produtos orgânicos por setor: alimentos, grãos, insumos (ex: fertilizantes), animais e carnes (inclui abatedouros e ração). Por fim, há a listagem (por província) de restaurantes e varejistas que compram produtos orgânicos, produtores de produtos orgânicos prontos para o consumo, sementes, terminando com laboratórios e centros de testes voltados ao setor.

5. RECOMENDAÇÕES

Conforme sinalizado de início, o presente documento teve como objetivo oferecer panorama geral do mercado para produtos orgânicos no Canadá. Tendo em vista o material exposto, não há dúvidas de que existe grande potencial para produtos orgânicos brasileiros nesse mercado, com ênfase na província da Colúmbia Britânica.

As informações colhidas indicam um mercado em expansão, abrangendo praticamente todos grupos demográficos. A valorização do produto orgânico já existe de forma abrangente e seu enquadramento como produto ligado à saúde e de maior qualidade implica uma maior aceitação de seu custo mais elevado vis-à-vis o equivalente não-orgânico.

De acordo com o estudo de mercado, conclui-se que existe um mercado significativo para alguns produtos orgânicos já promovidos pela APEX, principalmente: café (verde e torrado), frutas e polpas congeladas, sucos de frutas, cosméticos e perfumaria, frangos congelados, mel e suplementos alimentares. Seria de todo recomendável uma visita exploratória de produtores do setor à Colúmbia Britânica.

Como comentário final, acreditamos fortemente que o ideal seria o governo brasileiro negociar com o CFIA a obtenção de um acordo de equivalência de orgânicos entre os dois países (*“Organic Equivalency”*). A existência de tal acordo facilitaria imensamente a entrada de produtos com certificação brasileira de “orgânico”, que não precisariam de uma re-certificação ao entrar no Canadá.
