### **BRAZILIAN PROGRAM FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS**





- Official program of the Brazilian Government
- Offers free admission vacancies in Brazilian Higher Education Institutions (HEIs)
- 74 participating countries
- No quotas per country





# **PEC-G – UNDERGRADUATE LEVEL**

- Free admission vacancies for complete undergraduate courses
- Courses in all areas of knowledge
- Free applications every year at the Brazilian embassies and consulates in participating countries
- Students must return to their home countries upon graduation

# **PEC-PLE – PORTUGUESE COURSE**

- Free vacancies for Portuguese language and Brazilian culture course
- For those who need the Celpe-Bras certificate (official certificate of proficiency in Brazilian Portuguese) to enter PEC-G
- Course duration: aprox. 1 year
- At the end of the course, students must take the Celpe-Bras exam; once they obtain the certificate, they will start their undergraduate courses as PEC-G students




PEC-PLE students of the Federal University of the South Border (UFFS)



- Free admission for complete undergraduate course (plus free admission for Portuguese course, in the case of PEC-PLE students)
- Free medical, dental and pharmaceutical assistance by the Brazilian public health system
- Receive your diploma legalized or apostilled free of charge, at the Brazilian embassy or consulate where you applied for the program
- Access to HEIs' services and assistances
- In some cases, scholarships by the Brazilian Government


# VACANCIES

### PEC-G:

- Over 8.000 undergaduate vacancies
- 109 HEIs
- 280 different courses
- All Brazilian states

### **PEC-PLE**:

- Over 580 vacancies for Portuguese language course
- **30** HEIs
- 16 Brazilian states



# **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**



- Be a national of a country participating in the program
- Not be Brazilian and not be born to Brazilian parents
- Live outside of Brazil
- Not hold any type of visa for Brazil, except for a tourist visa



- Be at least 18 years old by January 1, 2025;
- Have completed or be completing secondary education (high school) in a country other than Brazil
- Have a general secondary education average of at least 60% (C)
- Meet the language requirements



 Have one or more sponsors who prove financial capacity to send funds to cover your expenses in Brazil (minimum amount: USD 300,00)

# LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

### IF YOU **STUDIED PORTUGUESE AS AN OFFICIAL LANGUAGE** AT SECONDARY SCHOOL:

- Celpe-Bras certificate, OR
- proof of application for the 2024/2 edition of the Celpe-Bras exam, OR
- intermediate level certificate of a Portuguese language course by Instituto Guimarães Rosa (IGR), OR
- overall average in the Portuguese language subject in secondary school of at least 65% (13 valores)



#### IF YOU **DID NOT STUDY PORTUGUESE AS AN OFFICIAL LANGUAGE** AT SECONDARY SCHOOL:


- Celpe-Bras certificate, OR
- proof of application for the 2024/2 edition of the Celpe-Bras exam, OR
- intermediate level certificate of a Portuguese language course by Instituto Guimarães Rosa (IGR), OR



• overall average in your official language subject in secondary school of at least 60%

## **FINANCIAL SPONSORS**



- Minimum amount to be sent to the student every month: USD 300
- Minimum net monthly income each sponsor must prove:
  3x higher than the amount promised to the student
- Financial sponsors may be individuals (family, friend, employer etc.) or legal entities (government, NGOs, companies etc.)
- If you have more than one sponsor, the promised amounts must add up to at least USD 300 (for example: if you have two sponsors, sponsor 1 may send USD 100 and sponsor 2 may send USD 200)
- Documents to be presented by sponsors: Statement of Financial Responsibility (TRF) and proof of income

# **HOW TO APPLY**



#### **STEP ONE** Fill in the **online application form** (link on the PEC-G website)



STEP TWO Learn about Brazilian HEIs and available courses. Decide which vacancies you are going to apply to (check the vacancies on the PEC-G website)



STEP THREE Contact the Brazilian embassy or consulate to learn how and when to present the required documents



STEP FOUR Present the required documents at the Brazilian embassy or consulate (check the list of documents on the PEC-G website) STEP FIVE Complete your



### FAQ

# "What is the maximum age to participate?"

There is no maximum age, only minimum age. You must be at least 18 years old by 01/01/2025.

# "How much does it cost to apply?"

Application is free. You don't need to hire third-party services. Please contact the Brazilian embassy or consulate directly.

### "I don't know Portuguese. Can I take the undergraduate course in another language?"

All PEC-G courses are in Portuguese. If you do not speak this language, you can apply for the PEC-PLE and spend your first year in Brazil studying Portuguese, to take the Celpe-Bras exam.



# "Will I receive financial aid/accommodation/meals/other aid from the HEI?"

It is not guaranteed. You will have equal access to the HEI's services and assistance programs as other students. However, some benefits are limited, have their own priority criteria or selection processes. Furthermore, not all HEIs have student housing and other benefits. This is why every student must have a financial sponsor who sends funds for their expenses in Brazil.

### "Will I receive a scholarship from the Brazilian Government?"

You will be able to apply for some scholarships from the Brazilian Government, but only after some time in the PEC-G.
