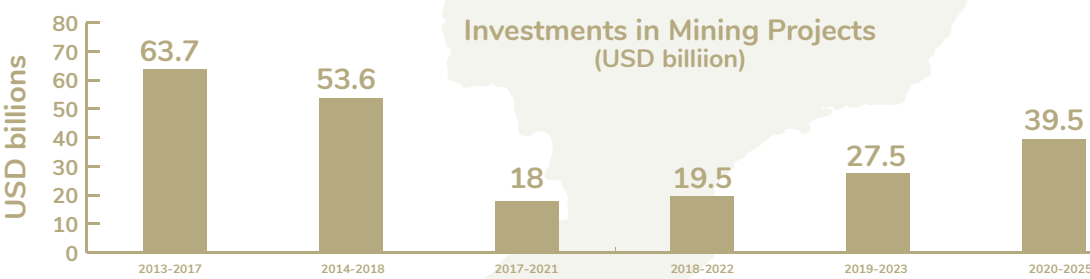

Why invest in the Mining Sector in Brazil?

- Brazil produces about **80** Mineral commodities with known reserves
- 11,758** Mining concessions (20/02/2021)
- Explored area: **0.6%** of the national territory
- Value of Mineral Production (IBRAM, 2020): **USD 40 billion** (estimated data)
- Mining share in national GDP (2018): **2.5%** considering the Mining Industry - excluding Oil and Gas

Miriri Phosphate Project at the State of Pernambuco

The phosphate Project includes seven mining rights in a total area of 6,112.18 ha

- Investment**: USD 38 million
- Ore Resources**: 114.7 bi tons
- Medium Grade**: 4,19% P₂O₅
- Bid notice**: 2Q 2021

Bom Jardim Copper and Gold Project at the State of Goiás

The Project has a total of 8,001.5m already drilled

- CAPEX**: USD 19,8 million
- Ore Resources**: 4.5 million tons
- Medium Grade**: 0.44% Cu and 0.025% Co
- Bid notice**: 2Q 2021
