

ZEB DISSEMINATION

- ZEB (net) Zero Energy Building- is a concept that energy input and output for buildings should be ultimately equal through energy conservation and renewables.
- JASE-W set up a working group of ZEB to host Workshops and Seminars on ZEB for ASEAN countries. And it facilitates ISO standardization on ZEB and it has been successfully enacted as Technical Specification since Sept.24th,2021.






