MORE THEN 70% OF BRAZIL'S POPULATION USE THE PUBLIC HEALTH SYSTEM EXCLUSEVELY

71,1% of Brazilian residents declare to use the public health care system (PNS 2013)

47,9 million Brazilians have some type health insurance (ANS 2017)

The public health system benefits every Brazilian with actions such as vaccinations programs, urgency network and surveillance








3.6 billion outpatient procedures between January and November 2017

- ✓ Largest Public Organ Transplantation System in the World
- √ 98% of the vaccine market is moved by SUS
- √ 3.6 billion outpatient procedures (Jan to Nov / 2016);
- ✓ 1.2 billion medical consultations / appointments (Jan to Nov / 2016);
- √ 12.4 million cancer procedures (Jan to Nov / 2016).



HEALTH SECTOR REPRESENTS 8% OF NATIONAL GDP




In 2013, public spending accounted for **45%** of health financing. The private sector for **55%**

- ✓ R\$ 125,3 billions (U\$ 40,4 bi) provided for in the Annual Budget Law (LOA) in 2017
- **√ 15%** Of the Net Current Income of the government applied in public health

- ✓ Strengthen the Industrial Health Complex
- ✓ Expand and update clinical protocols and therapeutic guidelines

- ✓ Strengthen actions to promote health and prevent diseases
- ✓ Implement the operation of Emergency Care Units, Basic Health Units, ambulances and equipment purchased and not installed ______
