

**SCHEDULE OF COMMITMENTS ON MOVEMENT OF NATURAL PERSONS
SINGAPORE**

The following sets out Singapore's commitments in accordance with Article 11.4 (Grant of Temporary Entry) in Chapter 11 (Movement of Natural Persons) in respect of the temporary entry and stay of natural persons of a State Party into the territory of another State Party.

Description of Category	Conditions and Limitations (including length of stay)
A. Business Visitors	
<p>Business Visitors are business persons who are seeking temporary entry into Singapore for business activity that is international in scope, and not seeking employment or residence in Singapore. Their primary source of remuneration, principal place of business and predominant place of accrual of profits remain outside Singapore.</p> <p>They may seek entry for the purpose of:</p> <p>a) conducting or attending business-related conferences, seminars or workshops;</p> <p>b) negotiating the sale of services or goods where such negotiations do not involve direct sales to the general public.</p>	<p>Entry of Business Visitors shall be subject to the fulfilment of eligibility requirements prevailing at the time of application.</p> <p>Entry for these Business Visitors is for up to 30 (thirty) days.</p>
B. Intra-Corporate Transferees	
<p>Intra-corporate transferees refers to managers, executives and specialists, as defined</p>	<p>Entry of Intra-Corporate Transferees shall be subject to the fulfilment of eligibility</p>

<p>below, who are employees of firms that provide services within Singapore through a branch, subsidiary, or affiliate established in Singapore and who have been in the prior employ of their firms outside Singapore for a period of not less than 1 (one) year immediately preceding the date of their application for admission and who are one of the following:</p> <p>(a) Managers - persons within an organisation who primarily direct the organisation, or a department or subdivision of the organisation, supervise and control the work of other supervisory, professional or managerial employees, have the authority to hire and fire or recommend hiring, firing, or other personnel actions (such as promotion or leave authorisation), and exercise discretionary authority over day-to-day operations. Does not include first-line supervisors, unless the employees supervised are professionals, nor does it include employees who primarily perform tasks necessary for the provision of the service.</p> <p>(b) Executives - persons within the organisation who primarily direct the management of the organisation, exercise wide latitude in decision-making, and receive only general supervision or direction from higher-level executives, the board of directors, or stockholders of the</p>	<p>requirements prevailing at the time of application.</p> <p>Entry for these Intra-Corporate Transferees is limited to a three-year period that may be extended for up to 2 (two) additional years, for a total term not exceeding 5 (five) years.</p> <p>For greater certainty, the extension period is subject to approval, and is subject to the eligibility requirements prevailing at the time of application of extension.</p>

Executives would not directly perform tasks related to the actual provision of the service or services of the organisation.</p> <p>(c) Specialists - persons within an organisation who possess knowledge at an advanced level of expertise and who possess proprietary knowledge of the organisation's service, research equipment, techniques, or management. (Specialists may include, but are not limited to, members of licensed professions).</p>	
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
